- A square yard is
 - A unit of volume
 - A unit of length (=lunghezza)
 - A unit of area
 - A unit of weight (=peso)
- The packet of biscuits you can buy from the school vending machine can weigh (=pesare):
 - 1 pound (lb)
 - 1 ton (t)
 - 1 ounce (oz)
 - 1/10 ounce
- If you are asking for 10 gallons of something you are:
 - Asking for a glass of water
 - Filling the tank (=serbatoio) of your car
 - Buying a big bottle of orange juice
 - Ordering enough water to fill your outdoor swimming pool
- A pint of milk is equal to:
 - About one litre
 - About one litre and a half
 - 0.33 litres
 - a bit less than half a litre
- If you are travelling through an Italian town you generally cannot drive faster than:
 - About half a mile per hour (0.5 mph)
 - About 100 miles per hour (100 mph)
 - About 8 miles per hour (8 mph)
 - About 30 miles per hour (30 mph)
- If today's temperature is 95° Farenheit
 - It's very cold
 - It's very hot
 - It's a pleasant November day
 - It's a pleasant summer day
- In the following words separate the prefix from the root of the word.

e.g. *supermarket*= *super*/*market*

- In the following words separate the suffix from the root (=radice) of the word.

e.g. *driver*= *driv*/*er*
